PROJECT NAME: Personnel Accountability and Assessment System Brochure

In order to personalize the case-management aspect of the application's abilities, the brochure's unique layout was made to simulate the inside of a case worker's folder, complete with personal notes, paper-clipped to photographs of real people in catastrophic situations. Personnel Accountability and Assessment System (PAAS) was derived from real world operational lessons learned during the Katrina hurricane. Version 1.0 of PAAS was rapidly designed, developed and delivered by SSC SD engineers between February and June 2006, in time for the 2006 hurricane season.





Adobe Captivate Screen Saver and Interactive Flash Tutorials

From a simple Power Point script, complex work sessions were recorded and made into manageable movie slides, overlaid with the original script in Captivate. The PAAS Captivate/Flash Screensaver was developed for intermittent display between demonstrations on a laptop computer during a joint military conference.

The NEP Flash tutorials featured an intuitive "forward" and "previous" slide mechanism, making jumps to each category quick and visually compelling. The Flash tutorials were available on every Enterprise Home Page for quick reference, to help guide portal users to the exact answer of usability or find refresher training.
